King's College Cricket Festival Dog Policy

King's College has been forced to adopt a policy of no dogs on site (with the exception of assistance/guide dogs). However, under exceptional circumstances permission may be granted subject to the following conditions being strictly observed.

- Dogs must be kept on their leads at all times.
- Dog mess must be cleared up and disposed of in the dog waste bin provided. The school litter bins must not be used for this purpose.
- Under no circumstances must you allow your dog to become a nuisance or cause any kind of disturbance.
- The School grounds must not be used to exercise your dog. For those attending the cricket festival please take a direct route from the car park to the boundary of the cricket pitch that your team is playing on.
